The Southend Bach Choir

The Southend Bach Choir began life in 1943 as an evening class of the Municipal College in Southend under the direction of its founder Dr. Harold May, FRCO. Known as the Municipal College Choir it gave its first performance in December of that year. The programme consisted of selections from Handel's Messiah.

In its early years the Municipal College Choral and Orchestral Society sponsored the birth of the College Opera Group, which became independent in 1950. In this year the choir's name reverted to "The Municipal College Choral Society" and many challenging concerts followed.

In 1968 the choir became the Southend Bach Choir, and in 1993 under the baton of Gerald Bates, (Musical Director 1987-2001) the Choir celebrated its Golden Jubilee with a memorable performance of Bach's B Minor Mass. Upon Gerry's retirement in 2001 the choir welcomed its present Musical Director Colin Edwards.

The choir will be celebrating its 80th anniversary in 2023.

Our Guest Soloists

Sofia Bagulho (Soprano) - Lisbon-native soprano Sofia Bagulho began her musical studies at the Conservatório de Música D. Dinis and at the Lisbon Conservatory, where she studied flute with Ricardo Alves and voice with Ângela Silva.

In 2019, she was admitted to the Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, in London, where she is completing a Bachelor's degree in Voice Performance under the guidance of Joan Rodgers, Jon Christos, and Robert Bottriell. In recent years, she has participated in several masterclasses with Elisabete Matos, Ana Paula Russo, Aylish Tynan, Susan Bullock, and Fiona Kimm, among others.

Sofia has been distinguished with several renowned prizes and awards. She was the first-prize winner of the Bendada Music Festival Concerto Competition and the Terras de Santiago International Music Competition. She has also been a prize winner at the Medici Music Competition, the Birmingham International Music Competition and Euterpe Music Awards. She was also selected to perform at the BBC PROMS 2022 with the BBC Symphony Chorus.

Sofia Bagulho has been offered a full scholarship to attend the master's program at the Royal College of Music, where she will continue her studies in the Fall of 2023.

Eve Rhodes (*Mezzo Soprano*) - With her expressive performance style, Eve Rhodes is currently a Mezzo-Soprano in her final year of undergraduate study at Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance. She has a particular interest in contemporary and early music as well as lieder and studies under the tutelage of Mary Wiegold.

Eve has much choral experience, having been a member of the chorus for Mendelssohn's *A Midsummer night's dream* at the BBC Proms and the British premiere of Golijov's *Oceana* with the BBC. She is a choral scholar at the Old Royal Naval College Chapel Choir under the direction of Ralph Allwood and enjoys singing at regular services, concerts and radio and television recordings with them. She has also performed with the Trinity Laban chamber choir under Stephen Jackson, Hilary Campbell and Naveen Arles. Eve studied in the Netherlands last year at Prince Claus Conservatoire in Groningen. There she performed in several concerts with the Luthers Bach ensemble.

She has so far sung roles such as Orfeo/Orfeo ed Eurydice, Nurse Proctor/The boy who grew too fast (Menotti) and Second Lady/Die Zauberflöte. She is looking forward to performing the role of Justine in Trinity Laban's summer opera, Frankenstein by Libby Larsen.

Eve regularly performs in chamber music ensembles from vocal consorts to groups involving French horn, piano and voice and recently performed with her pianist duo partner in a concert she organised combining classical performance with electronics and jazz.

She is very happy to be a soloist with the Southend Bach Choir singing absolutely fabulous music.

Cameron Gergett (Tenor) - Cameron is a Kathleen Roberts Scholar at Trinity Laban training to be a Tenor under Robert Alderson. Born in Belfast, Cameron is currently reading an MMus in Vocal performance. Cameron started singing at St Peters Cathedral Belfast when he was 17 before reading a BA in Music from Durham University, Whilst in Durham, Cameron was a member of the Durham Opera ensemble, performing in roles such as The Oueen of Hearts in Alice in Wonderland, Monostatos in Die Zauberflöte and Frank in Die Fledermaus. After graduating Cameron attained a Choral Scholarship at Liverpool Cathedral between 2019 and 2022. Whilst in Liverpool Cameron also regularly performed with the Liverpool Philharmonic Choir and Orchestra, and also regularly performs with the Liverpool Bach Collective. At Trinity Laban, Cameron has played in Opera Scenes: Tamino in Die Zauberflöte, Pedrillo in Die Entführung aus Serail, Fenton in Falstaff, Scaramuccio in Ariadne auf Naxos and the Male Chorus in The Rape of Lucretia. Recently Cameron also was the Tenor Soloist for Mozart's Requiem with Chorleywood Choral Society in a concert in aid of Ukrainian refugees. Cameron will be playing Ship Victor in Trinity Laban's upcoming performance of Frankenstein by Libby Larsen.

Dominic Felts (*Bass*) - Dominic is a Bass-Baritone singer from Lincolnshire now living in London, aged 22. With his flair and enthusiasm for choral music, Dominic is the senior choral scholar at the Old Royal Naval College in Greenwich under the musical direction of Ralph Allwood. He is also an alumnus of The Sixteen's young artists' programme Genesis Sixteen and Stile Antico's Youth Consort. After graduating from the University of Hull with a First-Class Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Music, Dominic began studying a Master of Music degree in Vocal Performance at Trinity Laban Conservatoire in September 2021. During his studies, Dominic has won both the Trinity Laban English Song and Lillian Ash French Song Competitions. Having had singing lessons with early music specialist, David Thomas, Dominic is keen to further explore early music repertoire in solo and ensemble contexts. He also studies with Peter Knapp, with coaching from Sebastian Wybrew.

Our Accompanist

Roger Humphrey - studied Organ, Piano, and conducting at the Royal College of Music, where he gained a degree of Bachelor of Music and was awarded his master of Arts degree at City of London University in 1993. He has held positions of Director of Music at Southend School for Boys, and lecturer in Performing Arts at South East Essex College. Roger is conductor of the Southend Choral Society, Director of Music at Holy Trinity Church, Southchurch, and accompanist to the Southend Bach Choir. He is also founder of the Southend Girls Choir, and a Director of the Southend Summer School for Performing Arts. Roger was appointed Director of the Southend Boys Choir in 1996 by the Southend Borough Council. In January 2000 Roger was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts for services to Music and the Arts.
